THE PROGRAM

Access to Home Program provides home modifications to enable New York City residents living with substantial physical limitations to remain safe and comfortable at home.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO PROVE ELIGIBILITY

- Medical verification of substantial disability/physical limitations
- Driver/Non-Driver License, Passport or IDNYC Card for proof of NYC residency
- Deed, title, mortgage to prove homeownership
- Social Security, disability, pension, public assistance, etc. to prove income
- Renters: property owners' approval

PROGRAM APPLICANTS ARE REQUIRED TO:

- be at least 18 years of age
- be substantially physically disabled/limited
- be New York City residents
- be homeowners or renters
- require modifications within their primary residence
- Non-veterans: household incomes at or below 80% of Area Median Income (i.e. \$90,720 for a one-person household in 2025)
- Veterans: certified by the US Department of Veterans Affairs or the Department of Defense as entitled to receive disability payments for a disability incurred in time of war and household incomes at 120 percent of area median income

TYPES OF MODIFICATIONS/INSTALLATIONS PROVIDED

- Walk/roll-in bathtubs/showers
- Kitchen retrofitting
- Wheelchair ramps/lifts
- Smart doorbells
- Grab bars
- Non-skid flooring
- Emergency/safety devices
- Shelf/lighting lowering
- Doorway expansion
- And more
